## From the PASTOR'S desk



**“The seed is the Word of God; the Sower is Christ;  
He who finds it abides forever”.**

We are inspired by the first reading from the prophet Ezekiel, who tells us that the day will come when, through King David, the world will know that God is Savior. The same people who generate fear will learn this. The prophet speaks of the Kingdom of God, which is already here. The Gospel, presents Him to us as a mustard seed, which sprouts and becomes a larger plant. Thus, the righteous will flourish, like a cedar, as they walk guided by faith and not by sight alone.

In our own way of seeing things, today we wonder what people think about the Kingdom of God? How to make the Work of God, from creation, be understood by those who do not have faith?

I ask this because a few years ago we were taught in school the social doctrine of the Church, there were classes of Religion, ethics and morals. Conduct and discipline were evaluated, there was more fear of God... We attended Sunday celebrations and all parish feasts as a group.

Now I feel regret because I see so many lonely young people, without God and without law... walkers not knowing where to go. Without goals, without hope and without visible achievements. So, what direction are they going to take in their lives if there are no laws, God, discipline and self-control?

It is very tedious for us, priests, parents and teachers, to maintain the motivation, and the pleasure for sacred things, in such hostile and libertine environments, where spiritual things no longer have the same value. Even the Sunday precept is no longer obligatory, given the Covid, and they justify themselves not to go to church to avoid contagion. So how long? Here we already have 100 percent capacity, but even so, many do not attend, although they are no longer exempt from personal attendance, as we experienced a little over a year ago.

We must understand that the Kingdom of God is to be with Him all day, all the time and in every place. Knowing how to spread the message of salvation left and right, without fear, as the apostles did, the great Saints and Martyrs, as the Mother Church affirms.

We are honoring in the month of June the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and in His name all our Fathers of the Family. I invite you, every single family, to get together, talk about your things, reorganize the house, clean and put everything in order. So is the Heart, the center of our life, as the house is the place of coexistence of all members; therefore, let us maintain order, joy and living and dynamic peace, so that our homes may be families of God and of healthy coexistence.

### ADULT'S SACRAMENTS-RCIA, OPEN

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is a process for adults, who freely wish to undertake the journey of faith and conversion, seeking for the living God through the Sacraments.

Eligible candidates for the program:

1. Adults who have not been baptized and wish to do so in the Catholic Faith.
2. Baptized Christians of other denominations who wish to be part of the Catholic Church.
3. Baptized Catholic adults who wish to receive the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation to complete the Christian Initiation Sacraments.
4. Baptized & Catechized catholic adults who have not yet completed the Sacrament of Confirmation

The classes will begin **September 2021**, For more information call the Faith Formation office at **1-718-639-6159**.

### SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR ADULTS 9 weeks (18 years and over)

Registrations are open, **classes will start on August, 2021**. Candidates to the sacrament must successfully complete the induction session to the sacrament, followed by the eight (8) sacrament preparation sessions. For a total of nine (9) weeks. **It is required that you bring all documents asked below at the moment of registration.**

Requirements:

- Birth Certificate.
- Recent Certificate of baptism.
- Recent Certificate of First Communion.

## Desde el Escritorio del PÁRROCO

Es muy tedioso para nosotros, los sacerdotes, los padres de familia y para los maestros, mantener la motivación, y el agrado por las cosas sagradas, en ambientes tan hostiles y libertinos, donde ya las cosas espirituales no tienen el mismo valor. Ya ni el precepto dominical es obligatorio, dado el covid, y se justifican de ir a las iglesias para evitar el contagio. ¿Entonces hasta cuándo? Aquí ya tenemos la capacidad al 100 por ciento, pero aún, muchos no asisten, aunque ya no están exentos de la asistencia personal, como lo experimentamos hace algo más de un año.

Hemos de entender que el Reino de Dios es estar con El todo el día, a todas horas y en todo lugar. Saber extender el mensaje de salvación a diestra y siniestra, sin temor, como lo hicieron los apóstoles, los grandes Santos y los Mártires, tal como lo afirma la madre Iglesia.

Estamos Honrando en el mes de junio al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, y en su nombre a todos nuestros Padres de Familia. Les invito para que, en cada familia, se reúnan, hablen de sus cosas, reorganicen la casa, limpien y pongan en orden todo. Each year Blessed Sacrament and the Diocese of Brooklyn engage in the *Annual Catholic Appeal* which supports Catholic programs throughout Brooklyn and Queens and affects the lives of countless individuals and families living in our neighborhoods in addition to benefitting our parish.

## How Does Our Parish Benefit?

In order for our parish to function, we need well trained **priests and deacons** who can celebrate the sacraments and administer the parish. Without the **\$2.5 Million** from the Appeal allocated to vocations, we would not have the clergy our parish needs.

Our Children are the future of our parish and we are called to support them as they grow in faith. The Appeal provides funding which supports every parish **religious education program** as well as tuition assistance to those seeking **Catholic Education** at Catholic Academies and Schools. Over **\$2 million** from the Appeal is invested in the faith of our children in addition to also providing **adult faith formation**. Instruction programs for lay people, including those in our own parish, provide training in ministries such as Eucharistic Ministers and Lectors or prepare others for sacraments.

The Appeal also provides the salaries for the trained Youth Ministers working in parishes throughout Brooklyn and Queens. **\$150,000** each year from our donations sustains the **Youth Ministry Initiative**, which has been supported by Generations of Faith, ensuring that young people encounter Christ through the Church, forming life-long bonds of faith which will sustain our parishes for years to come.

Christ Himself has called all of us to care for those among us in need, but as one parish we lack the time, space, skills and volunteers that it takes to address the needs of our brothers and sisters who need our help. This is why, through the Annual Catholic Appeal, our parish supports the work of **Catholic Charities** and **Catholic Migration Services** which receive a total of **\$1.4 million** from the Appeal. Together we are able to welcome the stranger, clothe the naked, feed the hungry and shelter the homeless in the name of our Church.

In our efforts to spread the Gospel of Christ we also have a responsibility as Catholics to minister to those who are ill, students in high schools and colleges as well as those who are imprisoned, just as Christ directed us to. The Appeal provides **\$1.9 million** to ensure that **chaplains** bring the sacraments of the church to those who are ill, imprisoned or are studying in high school and college.

## **Why is my participation important?**

As followers of Jesus here at Blessed Sacrament, we understand our responsibility to our parish implies a responsibility to the diocese which unites us together with the entire Catholic community as the one body of Christ.

When one part of the body does not participate, the entire body suffers and makes it harder to function. Instruction programs for lay people, including those in our own parish, provide training in ministries such as Eucharistic Ministers and Lectors or prepare others for sacraments.

The Appeal also provides the salaries for the trained Youth Ministers working in parishes throughout Brooklyn and Queens. **\$150,000** each year from our donations sustains the **Youth Ministry Initiative**, which has been supported by Generations of Faith, ensuring that young people encounter Christ through the Church, forming life-long bonds of faith which will sustain our parishes for years to come.

Christ Himself has called all of us to care for those among us in need, but as one parish we lack the time, space, skills and volunteers that it takes to address the needs of our brothers and sisters who need our help. This is why, through the Annual Catholic Appeal, our parish supports the work of **Catholic Charities** and **Catholic Migration Services** which receive a total of **\$1.4 million** from the Appeal. Together we are able to welcome the stranger, clothe the naked, feed the hungry and shelter the homeless in the name of our Church.

In our efforts to spread the Gospel of Christ we also have a responsibility as Catholics to minister to those who are ill, students in high schools and colleges as well as those who are imprisoned, just as Christ directed us to. The Appeal provides **\$1.9 million** to ensure that **chaplains** bring the sacraments of the church to those who are ill, imprisoned or are studying in high school and college.

## **Why is my participation important?**

As followers of Jesus here at Blessed Sacrament, we understand our responsibility to our parish implies a responsibility to the diocese which unites us together with the entire Catholic community as the one body of Christ.

When one part of the body does not participate, the entire body suffers and makes it harder to function. Likewise, your participation in this Appeal, over and above your regular Sunday offering, will determine the ability of Blessed Sacrament to faithfully support the mission of Christ while also providing the needed support we receive as one parish, which is part of the larger Catholic Church.
