## From the PASTOR'S desk



### "WOMAN, HOW GREAT IS YOUR FAITH"

In today's Gospel, Jesus knew that his "personal" mission was limited to the evangelization of the Jews, not of the pagans. But always above every law there is the urgency of the love of neighbor, which can force to make a parenthesis in the same law and here is the case: "The life of the Christian, of all the people of the world, is a life of love.

The life of the Christian, of the whole community, is a pilgrimage. There are no strangers: we are all fellow citizens of a new life, already introduced into our world and manifested in the banquet of the children of God, the banquet of the new covenant.

The first reading reminds us of the community born of the exile that was consolidated on the foundations of a new existence: the temple, the worship of the Sabbath, the law of the Lord and the means to maintain the covenant with Him, etc. were ways of life that establishes us and invites all believers to make prayer our best way of speaking and asking God at all times.

St. Paul to the Romans expresses today that neither before the Jews nor now the pagans can appeal to their religious situation to believe themselves privileged. God is not obligated to any people, to any civilization, to any political system. God, in order to appear to men, can use a luminous cloud or a stinking dunghill: "God locked us all in rebellion to have mercy on us all".

The most important thing of this day's reflection is to know how to grow and remain in our way of seeing and relating to God; the one who appears as an "unknown god" to many, as Paul said to the great sages in the Areopagus of Athens: "It is about this god that I want to speak to you and teach you.

Let us remember the phrase: "As great as your faith is, so be your works". May these be the mainstay of our LIFE, SO THAT WE SUPPORT AND GROW AS TRUE SENDERS.

La vida del cristiano, de toda la comunidad, es una peregrinación. No hay extranjeros: Todos somos conciudadanos de una nueva vida, ya introducida en nuestro mundo y que se manifiesta en el banquete de los hijos de Dios, banquete de la nueva alianza.

La primera lectura nos recuerda la comunidad nacida del exilio que fue consolidada en las bases de una nueva existencia: El templo, el culto al sábado, la ley del Señor y los medios para mantener la alianza con El, etc. han sido modos de vida que nos instaura e invita a todos los creyentes, a poner en la oración nuestra mejor manera de hablar y pedir a Dios en todo momento.

San Pablo a los Romanos expresa hoy que ni antes los judíos ni ahora los paganos pueden recurrir a su situación religiosa para creerse privilegiados. Dios no está obligado a ningún pueblo, a ninguna civilización, a ningún sistema político. Dios, para aparecerse a los hombres, puede utilizar una nube luminosa o un estercolero maloliente: “Dios nos encerró a todos en la rebeldía para tener misericordia de todos nosotros”.

Lo mas importante de esta reflexión del día, es saber crecer y permanecer en nuestra forma de ver y de relacionarnos con Dios; el que aparece como “dios desconocido” para muchos, como les decía pablo a los grandes sabios en el areópago de Atenas: De ese dios es el que quiero yo hablarles y enseñarles.

Recordemos la frase: “Tan grande como sea tu Fe, sean también tus obras”. Que estas sean el puntal de nuestra VIDA, PARA QUE NOS APOYEMOS Y CREZCAMOS COMO VERDADEROS ENVIADOS.



## HISTORICAL REVIEW

### The Beginnings of Blessed Sacrament Parish...

In 1898 Queens County joined Manhattan, Brooklyn, The Bronx and Staten Island to form New York City. At the time, the area of Trains Meadow, now known as Jackson Heights, was a rural farming community. The landscape of the area would change once the Queensboro Bridge opened in March 1909. Now connected directly to Manhattan, the area was ripe for development as a residential community. By late 1909, The Queensboro Corporation, under the direction of Edward Archibald MacDougall, began negotiating the purchase of tracts of land from local farmers. Between 1910 and 1914 the Queensboro Corporation purchased 28 different farms, totaling roughly 350 acres stretching from 70th Street to 92nd Street, bounded by Northern Boulevard and Roosevelt Avenue now known as Jackson Heights.

Until the mid 1920's the area now included in Blessed Sacrament Parish was not densely populated. Increasing development and the continuing flight of many Manhattan residents to suburban Queens County led the diocesan authorities to the realization that a new parish would be needed for the residents of eastern Jackson Heights and western Corona.



The third Bishop of Brooklyn, the Most Reverend Thomas E. Molloy established the new parish of the Blessed Sacrament on June 5, 1929. The first pastor, Father James McMahon, celebrated the first Mass for the newly established parish on June 29, 1929. Father McMahon lived at St. Joan of Arc rectory as a guest of Father Meehan for a brief period of time. By October 7, 1929 he was able to secure lodgings at 35-11 93rd Street. Meanwhile, by September 8, 1929, the old wooden chapel was enlarged to accommodate the many parishioners of the new parish. Even though the Great Depression began on October 19, 1929, the parishioners of Blessed Sacrament rallied to preserve their fledgling church despite the national financial disaster. Father McMahon was assigned an Associate Pastor, Father Austin Hughes, to assist him in organizing the parish. They would be joined the following year by Father Jeremiah King.

Parishes societies were formed. The first parish carnival was celebrated in October 1929. The new parish's first Holy Communion class received Our Lord in the Eucharist on May 30, 1930. That same year saw the establishment of the Young Men's Lyceum, the forerunner of many youth programs.
