WHO IS THIS THAT EVEN THE WIND AND THE WATERS OBEY HIM?

We know that the Christian is founded on the cornerstone of Christ, who died and rose again to give us the assurance of our victory. The strength that makes us overcome all fear is communicated to us by the power of the Father, who is in heaven, and by our total faith in eternal life.

In the first reading the Lord spoke to Job in despair, pious and heroic, he speaks for mankind who asks God for a reason for his suffering, instead of receiving an answer to his question, he is led to contemplate the universe and asked to give an explanation of its unfathomable wonder. The impetuous sea invites him to contemplate it with tenderness in its birth and in the scrupulous obedience to its laws. Job senses that in the whole universe there are traces of someone’s love and infinite wisdom. He meets God, and then his questions no longer ask for an answer.

Psalm 106 always reminds us: “Give thanks to the Lord, for his mercy endures forever”.

he second reading reminds us that the old has passed away, the new has begun; for Christ died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died for them and rose again. Therefore, we value no one according to the flesh. “He that is Christ’s is a new creature.” Now let us see, how new are we and in what ways have we assimilated the eternal inheritance of which the Church speaks to us in the New Testament?

The gospel reminds us of the episode when He said “Let us go to the other shore”, leaving the people, they took Him away in a boat and there was a great storm and He was sleeping. Here we see the figure of the boat as the symbol of the church. Also today there are many cowardly and complaining Christians, who speak only of crises of faith and of religious and moral tragedies. If Jesus is in our boat, why don’t we awaken him with our robust faith and hopeful optimism?

By celebrating the Eucharist, we remember that Christ has shared the risk of human existence, and at the same time we enhance our hope in his strength and salvation. We live in true communion because we know that God is with us and guarantees us security in the final triumph.

Today I begin my last week as Pastor of St. Sacrament and before retiring I want to invite you to celebrate my 22nd Priestly Anniversary next Saturday, June 29th in the Valero Hall at 8 am, followed by a small fraternal breakfast for those who want to join me. Space is limited to 250 people so that I can say goodbye to some of you. There will be no 9:00 am mass, you may attend at 8 am as well. Thank you.

¿QUIÉN ES ESTE QUE HASTA EL VIENTO Y LAS AGUAS LE OBEDECEN?

Sabemos que el cristiano está cimentado sobre la piedra angular de Cristo, que ha muerto y resucitado para darnos la seguridad de nuestra victoria. La fortaleza que nos hace superar todo temor se nos comunica por el poder del Padre, que está en los cielos, y por nuestra fe total en la vida eterna.

En la primera lectura el Señor le habló a Job desesperado, piadoso y heroico, habla por la humanidad que pide a Dios razón del sufrimiento, en lugar de recibir una respuesta a su pregunta, es llevado, a contemplar el universo y requerido al dar explicación de su inabarcable maravilla. El mar impetuoso lo invita a contemplarlo con ternura en su nacer y en la escrupulosa obediencia a sus leyes. Job intuye que en el universo entero hay huellas del amor de alguien y de sabiduría infinita. Se encuentra con Dios, y entonces sus interrogantes ya no piden respuesta.

El Salmo 106 nos recuerda siempre "Dad gracias al Señor, porque es eterna su misericordia".

La segunda lectura nos recuerda que lo antiguo ha pasado, lo nuevo ha comenzado; pues Cristo murió por todos, para que los que viven ya no viven para sí, sino para El, que murió y resucitó por ellos. Por tanto, no valoramos a nadie según la carne. "El que es de Cristo es una criatura nueva". Ahora veamos, ¿qué tan nuevos somos nosotros y de qué maneras hemos asimilado la herencia eterna de la que nos habla la Iglesia en el nuevo testamento?

El evangelio nos recuerda el episodio de cuando dijo "Vamos a la otra orilla", dejando a la gente, se lo llevaron en una barca y hubo una gran tempestad y Él estaba durmiendo. Aquí vemos la figura de la barca como el símbolo de la iglesia. También hoy hay muchos cristianos cobardes y quejumbrosos, que no hablan mas que de crisis de fe y de tragedias religiosas y morales. Si Jesús va en nuestra barca, ¿Por qué no lo despertamos con nuestra fe robusta y con nuestro optimismo esperanzador?

Al Celebrar la Eucaristía, recordamos que Cristo ha compartido el riesgo de la existencia humana, y al mismo tiempo potenciamos nuestra esperanza en su fuerza y en su salvación. Vivimos en comunión verdadera porque sabemos que Dios está con nosotros y nos garantiza seguridad en el triunfo final.

Desde hoy empiezo mi última semana como Párroco del Santísimo Sacramento y antes de retirarme quiero invitarles a Celebrar mis 22º Aniversario Sacerdotal el próximo sábado 29 de junio en el salón Valero a las 8 am, seguido de un pequeño desayuno fraternal, para quienes me quieran acompañar. El cupo esta limitado a 250 personas y así podré despedirme de algunos de ustedes. No habrá misa de las 9:00 am, pueden asistir a las 8am también. Gracias.

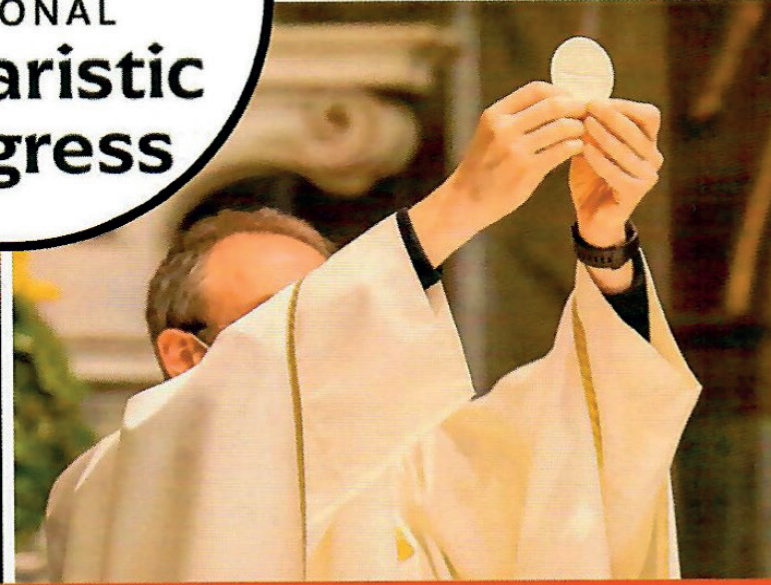
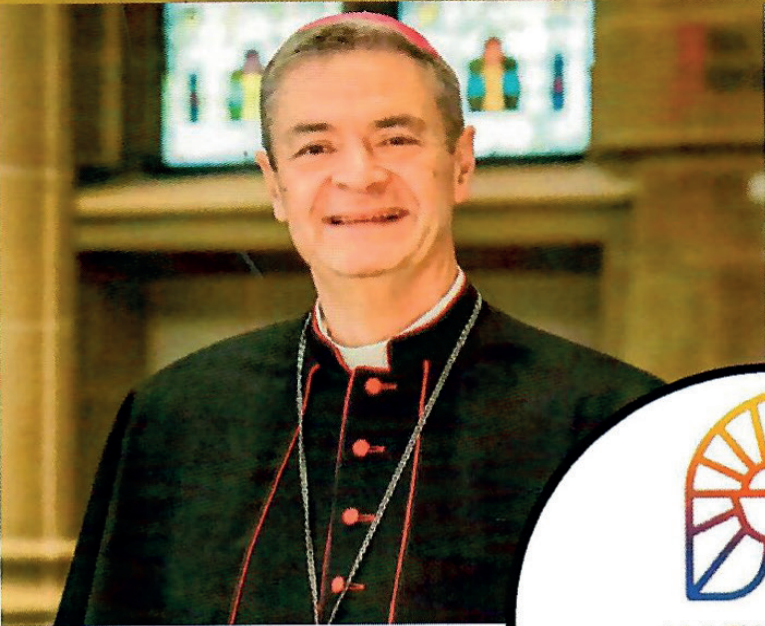

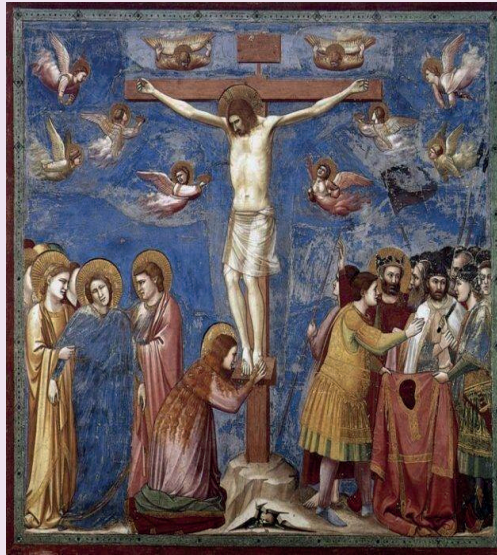
